New features:

- BATV- filter (Bounce Address Tag Validation):
New filter for blocking of fake undeliverable messages.

IMPORTANT:

To activate/ to configure the filter, you need to have the latest administrator console 1024.

- You have the opportunity to reorganize the database via the appliance console.
- Userspace Vmware- Tools (only for REDDOXX virtual appliance):
Enable shutdown by VMware host and time synchronization.

- Important! Update of the virus scanners (Clam 0.93 security-fix).
- The daily reports are compiled quicker, with large numbers of users.
- Failure when shutting down, if the service had already been shut down.
- Time synchronization of REDDOXX Virtual Appliance.

- Correction of notifications when showing the statistics.
- The list of the updates gets automatically update after the download started.

Notes for updating to Build 1024 Final

1. Requirements

In order to be able to update your REDDOXX appliance to build 1024 FINAL, build 1024 BETA SP1 or Build 1023 SP1 has to be installed on the appliance.

2. Request update

In the admin console at “Appliance Administration/Updates“ you can request the update. After that, the updates are being downloaded to the appliance and are available for installation after a few moment. Note: By pressing F5 you can refresh the list. Should your appliance not be running on 1024 Final, this build will be transmitted likewise. Service packs have to be requested and installed individually.

The updates have to be installed in the proper order. Should you be running a version that is older than build 1017 please contact REDDOXX support in order to receive the updates.

3. Install updates

In order to install an update, please select the respective update from the list shown at “Appliance Administration/Updates“. By clicking the right mouse button you can install the update. After a successful update, the appliance needs to be rebooted.

4. Check if software subscription is valid

Since Build 1020 software updates can be requested only with a valid subscription.
